These terms and conditions are additional to the full terms and conditions contained in Scenic Tours Canada, Alaska & The United States of America 2013 brochure. All bookings are subject to Scenic Tours full terms and conditions. This flyer is supplementary to the full brochure. Please note tours may not operate in all months and are subject to availability. Prices are land only and are based on per person twin share in AUD.

1. Pre Release Information

1.1 Book Now for 2014 and Pay 2013 Prices

(a) Price for 2013 will be held for 2014 travel on tours operated by Scenic Tours

(b) Any third party operators such as but not limited to flights are subject to applicable fares and conditions for travel in the chosen period. These are not guaranteed to be held at 2013 prices.

(c) A refundable booking deposit of \$250 per person per tour must be paid within 7 days of making a booking. Upon the release of the Scenic Tours Canada, Alaska & the USA 2014 Brochure a further \$1250 per person deposit must be paid within 7 days. Once received, the \$1500 deposit is non-refundable. A further \$2750 per person per tour is required when selecting an Earlybird Offer and must be paid within 7 days of the Canada, Alaska & the USA 2014 brochure release. Once received, the \$3000 per person deposit is non-refundable.

(d) If the itinerary duration is amended and additional nights are included in a tour the additional cost will be surcharged.

(e) Pre Release offers are only available prior to the release of the full Scenic Tours Canada, Alaska & the United States of America 2014 Brochure. Pre Release offers are strictly limited and are available until sold out or withdrawn.

2.2 Taxes

Dependant on departure date and time of booking the required booking class for airfare offer may be too far in advance to book with the appropriate airline. If the required booking class is unavailable air surcharges will apply. The flight quote including air taxes and surcharges will be confirmed once all air sectors are booked and confirmed. 2.4 Airline Baggage Fees

3. Tour Price

3.1 What's included in the Tour Price?

3.4 How do You pay?

Final Payment

(a) You must pay the balance of the Tour Price to Us no later than 90 days before the Tour Departure Date.

(b) All Tour Prices are quoted in Australian dollars.

Payments to Travel Agents

(c) If You have booked through a travel agent, Your travel agent should forward Your Booking Deposit or Tour Price to Us on Your behalf. However, payments by You to Your travel agent are not considered to be payments by You to Us. We will consider payment has been received by Us from You when We receive payment from Your travel agent.

4. Fees

Variation Fee

(b) Third party operators may charge their own variation fees for booking changes. If we incur any third party variation fees on Your behalf You must reimburse Us.

(c) We may accept or reject Your request for variation at Our absolute discretion.

Cancellation Fee

(d) Any cancellation of the Tour by You prior to Your Tour Departure Date (including any changes to Your Tour Departure Date, Tour Code or name change) will result in the following cancellation fees:

(h) You must pay for all expenses which arise due to changes to Your Itinerary after Your Tour Departure Date. This includes changes due to illness or other personal reasons.
